In the Garden July Garden Tasks

Tips from Dennis and Bill



Stop by our Cole Street garden center for all your gardening needs. The advice is free from the Garden Guys, Dennis and Bill. E-mail them with any questions: dennis@colehardware.com or blitz@colehardware.com.

Our dry season should be in full swing now as we enter the first full month of summer. Don't let your garden dry out. Watering early in the morning is best. Evening watering is preferable to watering in the heat of the day, but it can promote disease. Weeds steal valuable water, so make sure to keep them under control. These long summer days provide an ideal opportunity for enjoying your garden.

✓ **Fertilizer:** Annuals, perennials, and trees will enjoy a boost of nitrogen. Use an all-purpose fertilizer such as Espoma® Plant-tone. (Sku 7122930, \$9.99) After azaleas, camellias, and rhododendrons have finished blooming, use an acid-loving plant food on these. We recommend Espoma® Holly-tone. (Sku 7122773, \$9.99)



✓ **Wisterias:** These should have finished blooming, and long growth can be cut back by about half. This will stimulate the plants to form flower buds and reduce long, tangled growth—especially if it is growing onto eaves or windows.

✓ **Indoor plants:** For plants to be effective in cleaning indoor air, NASA suggests one potted plant per 100 square feet of indoor space. Some common indoor plants that are effective in removing formaldehyde, benzene, and carbon monoxide from the air include English ivy, gerbera daisies, peace lilies, and chrysanthemums.

✓ **Vegetables:** Plant a second crop of vegetables now: beets, bush beans, carrots, radishes, cabbage, cauliflower, fava beans, and turnips. Harvesting your vegetables while they are young, and on a regular basis, will keep them productively fruiting. Harvest early in the day.

✓ **Bearded irises:** Cut irises back to about 3 or 4 inches after they have finished blooming. You can dig up and divide the rhizomes (root mass) by cutting them apart. Let them dry for a day or so in a dark place. They can then be replanted.

✓ **Color:** Now is the time to plant summer flowering perennials, shrubs, and annuals. Marigolds, petunias, salvia, and begonias should all do the trick to make your garden bright and colorful.

✓ **Herbs:** Dry herbs by tying in bunches with raffia or ribbon. These make ideal hostess gifts when attending friends' backyard barbecues.

✓ **Aphids:** Combat aphids with a strong spray from the hose, with ladybugs, or with Safer® Insecticidal Soap. (Sku 74805, \$9.49) Release ladybugs in the evening at the base of your plant. If released during the day, the ladybugs will fly away. As they crawl up the plant, they will feast on the aphids.



✓ **Butterfly-loving plants:** To attract butterflies to your garden, it is essential to plant nectar-producing flowers for them to feed on. Our stores sell Botanical Interests®

Bring Home the Butterflies seed packs. (Sku 701283, \$3.99) Also consider these plants:

- Flowers: goldenrod, milkweed, sunset, marigolds, cosmos, Mexican sunflowers, and phlox



- Vegetables: broccoli, kale, and cabbage
- Herbs: catnip, lavender, thyme, dill, sage, and parsley



✓ **Honeybee-friendly plants:** Our garden centers stock plants from local suppliers Blooms and Sweetwater. These are honeybee friendly and free of the insecticides neonicotinoids, which are believed to be a possible cause of the honeybee colony collapse syndrome. We also stock

Botanical Interests® Save the Bees seed packs. (Sku 701295, \$4.99)

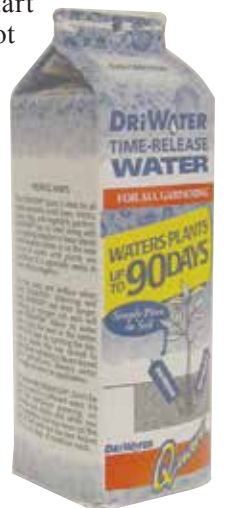

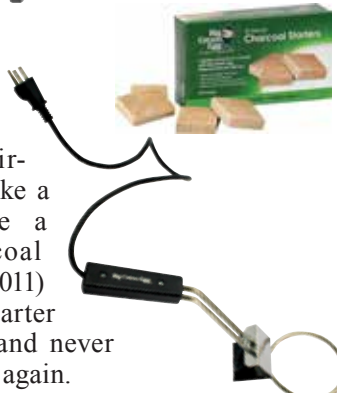

Paint Brush Choice and Care Better Brushes, Better Results

Though people may spend hours pondering the right paint type and hue for their redecorating project, they often don't devote enough time selecting the proper brush for the job. Just as paints are available in a wide array of types, paintbrushes also offer an abundance of options.

You may be tempted to "make do" with a less-expensive brush, but the difference in price between an inferior brush and a good-quality one is far outweighed by the ease of application and superior results. Furthermore, you'll save money in the long run with a brush that can withstand project after project.

All brushes are not created alike. The type of paint used will dictate the best brush for the job. Paint brush bristles (fibers) fall into two general categories: **natural bristles** and **synthetic bristles**. Natural bristle brushes should be



require an angular brush. Long handles on trim and sash brushes make it easy to reach into hard-to-get places and are good for "cutting in."

Checking for quality.

Paint brushes should always be springy, and a good brush will get better with use. Cheap brushes have silky bristles that tend to break easily. On a good-quality brush, at least half the bristles will have split ends ("flags")—these hold more paint and spread it out more uniformly.

To check for quality, hit the brush against your hand and fan the bristles to see if they come out easily. If you've decided to use a cheap brush, keep a pair of tweezers handy to immediately pick loose bristles off the freshly painted surface.

Now that you own a superior brush, take care of it!

The lifetime of a brush is determined to a large degree on the treatment it receives. Whenever possible, retain the original brush keeper and cleaning instructions. Many professionals clean their brushes more than once during the workday to prolong the life of their tools. Here are some tips to help you extend the life of your new paint brushes:

- Before using a new paint brush with oil-based paint, soak it for a day in linseed oil. The brush will last longer and be easier to clean.
- Before loading a brush with a water-based product, dampen it with water. This will draw some of the water into the ferrule (which holds the brushes' bristles) and prevent paint from drying out the brush during use. It will also prevent paint from clumping as you work and make cleanup easier.
- Resist the temptation to use your larger brush edgewise—the rounding off of brush corners shortens brush life and produces an inferior paint job. Use a brush designed to be used edgewise, or paint with the flat surface of a smaller brush.
- For each type of paint, there is a specially formulated solvent that works best to remove residue from the brush. Be sure to use the appropriate cleaner.
- "Fingering," the clumpy separation of filaments, occurs when a brush is only half cleaned and allowed to dry with paint residue holding the filaments crooked. To avoid fingering, clean brushes properly.
- To clean brushes, remove excess paint by wiping the brush on sheets of old newspaper. Then pour an inch or two of the correct solvent into a clean can or bucket. Press the bristles down and work the brush up and down against the bottom of the can to bring all the bristles in contact with the solvent. Do this for a minute or two and then wipe the bristles almost dry by again stroking the brush across sheets of old newspaper. Replace the dirty solvent with clean and repeat the washing process two or three times. Give the brush a final washing in warm water and detergent. Then comb the bristles flat by using a metal brush comb or a coarse hair comb (do not comb with a wire brush). Pat the brush dry with a paper towel, and then place it in its original packaging or brown wrapping paper secured with tape. Store the brush hanging by its handle or lying flat.

used only with oil-based (solvent) products. Do not use natural bristle brushes with latex (water-based) paint. Natural bristles will absorb the water in latex paint and soften—causing the finish coat of paint to have streaks or other noticeable defects.

Synthetic bristle brushes are made from man-made materials such as polyester or nylon and are excellent for latex and other water-base products because they hold their shape and resiliency. They are also easy to clean, and their filaments will not soften and become limp. They can also be used for oil-base paints.

Use the right size brush.

It may seem elementary, but using the right size brush will save you time and effort and give you far better results. One-inch brushes are made for trim, shutters, and most touch-up. Four-inch brushes are designed for painting larger surface areas such as interior walls, paneling, exterior siding, and so on. A project with sharp angles or other unusual surfaces may



Saw Blades: Pick the Right One for Your Project

Saw blades are designed with specific features to get the job done. Here are some characteristics to look for when you shop for a saw blade:

Heat vents and expansion slots. Heat buildup can distort a blade or cause it to lose its tempering. Heat vents are cut into the blade's body to help the blade cool as it cuts. Expansion slots are cut into the perimeter of the blade, allowing it to expand without distorting.

Roundness. Blade roundness impacts cutting accuracy and product life. The hole used for mounting the blade to the saw—called the "arbor"—must be perfectly round and exactly on center to prevent wobble and uneven cutting.

Kerf. Kerf is the saw blade's thickness. Thinner kerf wastes less material—and is designed to cut with minimal friction and without binding. Thick kerf has more cutting power.

Carbide vs. steel. A carbide

blade will cut better and last longer than a steel blade. C4-grade carbide is the hardest material—saw blades designed for professionals are normally made of C4 carbide. C3- and C2-grade carbide blades are designed for the do-it-yourselfer.

Coatings. A black silicone coating is added to the best C4 carbide blades, resulting in smoother cutting and no pitch or resin buildup. (The silicone also reduces friction and heat buildup, thus extending the life of the blade.) Saw blades may also be treated with silicone or lacquer to reduce oxidation (rust).

Blade types. Generally speaking, the more teeth, the smoother and more accurate the cut. A typical 7 1/4" ripping blade might have 12 to 24 teeth, a general-purpose crosscut blade might have 40 teeth, and a trim and finishing blade might have up to 60 teeth. The "grind" is also important. Look for precision grinding on the top, sides, and face of each tooth—this ensures safe and accurate cutting without chipping the material.

After completion of the program, Get Up! students will design their own capstone project, offering 40 hours of community service to the local urban agriculture, food justice, or nutrition literacy project of their choice.

- New skills and knowledge essential to organic gardening, sustainable landscaping, and urban agriculture
- An understanding of the importance of sustainable agriculture
- The experience and ability to teach a two-hour composting class at GFE
- A supportive community of like-minded individuals committed to leading positive change

All classes take place at the Garden for the Environment garden at 7th Avenue and Lawton Street. To apply for Get Up! or to sign up for any classes, visit www.gardenfortheenvironment.org. The Edible Plants and Backyard Apothecary workshops each cost to addend, although no one will be turned away for lack of funds. Preregistration is required.

Copper and brass.

SPENT FLUORESCENT BULBS:

CFLs, tubes up to 8 feet, U- and D-shaped tubes. Drop-off limit is 10 bulbs.

EXPIRED PRINTER CARTRIDGES:

Must be in plastic bags to avoid leakage.

SOFT PLASTIC:

Clean plastic only. Households only. One basketball-size amount per visit, please.
